

Dear Guest.

Welcome aboard "After You". Although we place a high premium on fun, this comes secondary to safety. Prior to each voyage, preparations are made in accordance with the highest standards of safety, navigation, and piloting. Once underway, the Captain will not modify the float plan unless safety or other conditions dictate as prudent. Feel free to review the float plan with the Captain prior to departure and use that opportunity to voice concerns and/or desired course deviations. Otherwise we stay on plan. Thank you for your cooperation.

For your safety, this vessel exceeds all Coast Guard safety requirements. The vessel is equipped with a state of the art solar/electrical system, diesel fueled engines and generator, 10 stage water treatment system, numerous alarm systems and 6 bilge pumps collectively capable of pumping 1 gallon per second. However, most of the best lifesaving gear aboard is taken with you in the event the vessel must be abandoned. All gear can be found under the starboard sofa seat cushion or next to the electrical panel.

Critical items include:

- -Personal Flotation Devices Including 2 Inflatable PFDs installed with independent satellite personal locator beacons (PLBs), strobes and other lifesaving gear
- -6 Person Inflatable Coastal life Raft
- -Go Bag with signaling devices, additional PLB and other lifesaving items
- -Hand Held VHF Radio with GPS and digital selective calling
- -Iridium Network Satellite Communicator (satellite texting)

Before getting underway, please familiarize yourself with items on the safety tab of the guest website and the locations of the aforementioned safety gear.
